VENUE INFORMATION:

- Lisa Wise Day will be taking place at Kings Academy, Binfield (Wood Lane, RG42 4FS) on the outdoor courts.
- Parking is available on site however this is **limited**. Please car share as much as possible.
- If the car park is full, there is a small car park to the north of the school where you can walk down to the entrance of the school (Google maps location [here](#)).
- Toilets and changing facilities are located within the sports hall, in addition to a water fountain.

UMPIRING

- Each team are required to provide a qualified (C award or above) umpire(s).
- You will be required to umpire the game **after** you have played, on the same court, with the exception of the first round of fixtures. **For the first round of fixtures, those that are playing ROUND 2 are required to umpire Round 1 (on the court which you will then play).**
- Umpires can be playing umpires, however please note that they could be playing, umpiring, playing etc. with limited breaks. Please make sure your umpire is happy with this as it will be very warm. We would recommend a couple of umpires if you have playing umpires only.
- Please can we ask all umpires to have a white top to ensure no confusion between the teams.

SCORING

- You will always score the game **after** you have played, on the same court with the exception of the first round of fixtures. **For the first round of fixtures, those that are playing ROUND 2 are required to score Round 1 (on the court which you will then play).**
- Teams will have scorecards for **their** games and are required to give the scorecard to the scorers before the beginning of the match.
- Please bring a pen and your scorecard to each match.
- Scorecards to be taken back to the results table after the match has concluded.



MATCHES

- There are three groups (which are based on abilities): **blue**, **red** and **green**.
- Fixtures are provided separately (email and website)
- Timings of each match are as follows:
 - 6 minutes each way
 - Straight swap at half time
 - 4 minutes between each game
- Central timing will take place.
- You must have a minimum of 5 players on court at one time.
- Only injury substitutions can be made (no tactical changes)
- The first team listed (home team) in the fixture will get the centre pass, the second (away team) chooses which end.
- Scoring will be as follows:
 - Win 5 points
 - Draw 3 points
 - Half or within half of score 1 point
- You will play each team **twice** and therefore have a total of **10 games** each.
- There will be no finals, the winners will be the team finishing first in each group.

EQUIPMENT AND OTHER INFORMATION:

- **Match Ball** - each team to have a match ball – please bring this to each game for umpires to choose.
- **First Aid Kit** - a first aid kit will be at the results table but we recommend that each team also brings their own.
- **Bibs / Patches** - we would recommend that each team have a set of different colour bibs (or overalls if you wear patches) in case of colour clashes.

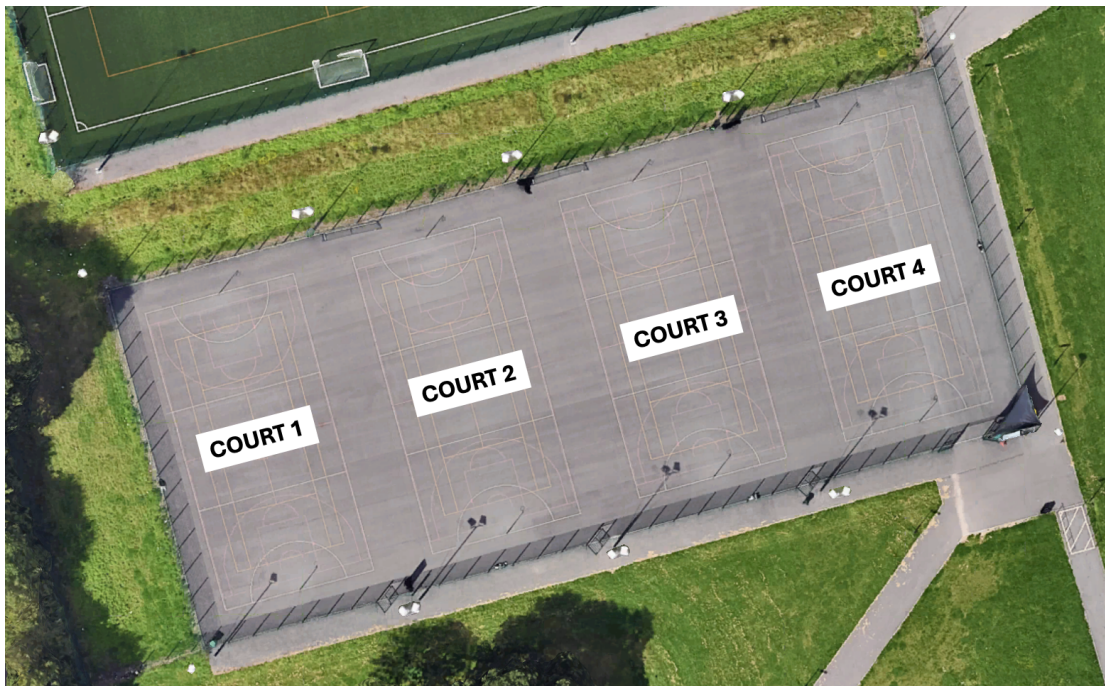

OTHER INFORMATION:
